Minutes

The minutes of the previous meeting August 27, 2025 was presented. JR Hachadurian motioned to approve, seconded by Kay House. During discussion, staff requested that BOE should be put after Marion in third bullet point to clarify the early voting is held at the board of elections office. JR Hachadurian withdrew his motion. Kay House motioned to approve the revision/amendment to the minutes, seconded by Tracey Bolick. The motion carried unanimously 4-0.

Barbara Hilty made the motion to have the board secretary delegate the taking of the minutes to the staff. - 1. At this time no absentee requests have been received for the Municipal election, 11-4-25.
- 2. The list of Election Day and Early Voting precinct officials for the Municipal election was presented to the board. JR Hachadurian wanted to ensure the staff has the same authority as in the past to replace any workers that are unable to work either on election day or early voting as long as the pollworkers have been approved by the political parties they represent.
- 3. Discussion of Early Voting for March, 2026. The staff made recommendations and this will be voted on at a later date. The vote must be done with all 5 board members in attendance.
- 4. Due to Hurricane Helene and the damage suffered the staff expressed concerns for the readiness of the Old Fort Wesleyan Church for the March, 2026 Primary. The staff recommends to utilize the Old Fort Depot for both the Old Fort #1 and Old Fort #2 precincts combined for the Primary, 2026 election. The hope is for the church to complete the repairs needed in time for the November, 2026 General election. Kay House motioned to approve the change for the March, 2026 Primary and Second Primary, if necessary, seconded by Tracey Bolick. The motion carried unanimously 4-0.
- 5. Jane Propst, Director in Training explained the Student Election Assistant application and appointment process. Three applications were presented to the board for the Municipal election. Barbara Hilty motioned to approve, seconded by Kay House. The motion carried unanimously 4-0.
